Demand Will Surge For Video Analytics



In the past, video analytics were reserved for businesses with big budgets. Video analytics have become much more affordable and easier to deploy, making them accessible to the masses. Large Enterprises Will Opt For Access Control As A Service

According to an IHS Markit report, large enterprises will make up 19% of the Access Control-as-a-Service (ACaaS) market by 2022.
